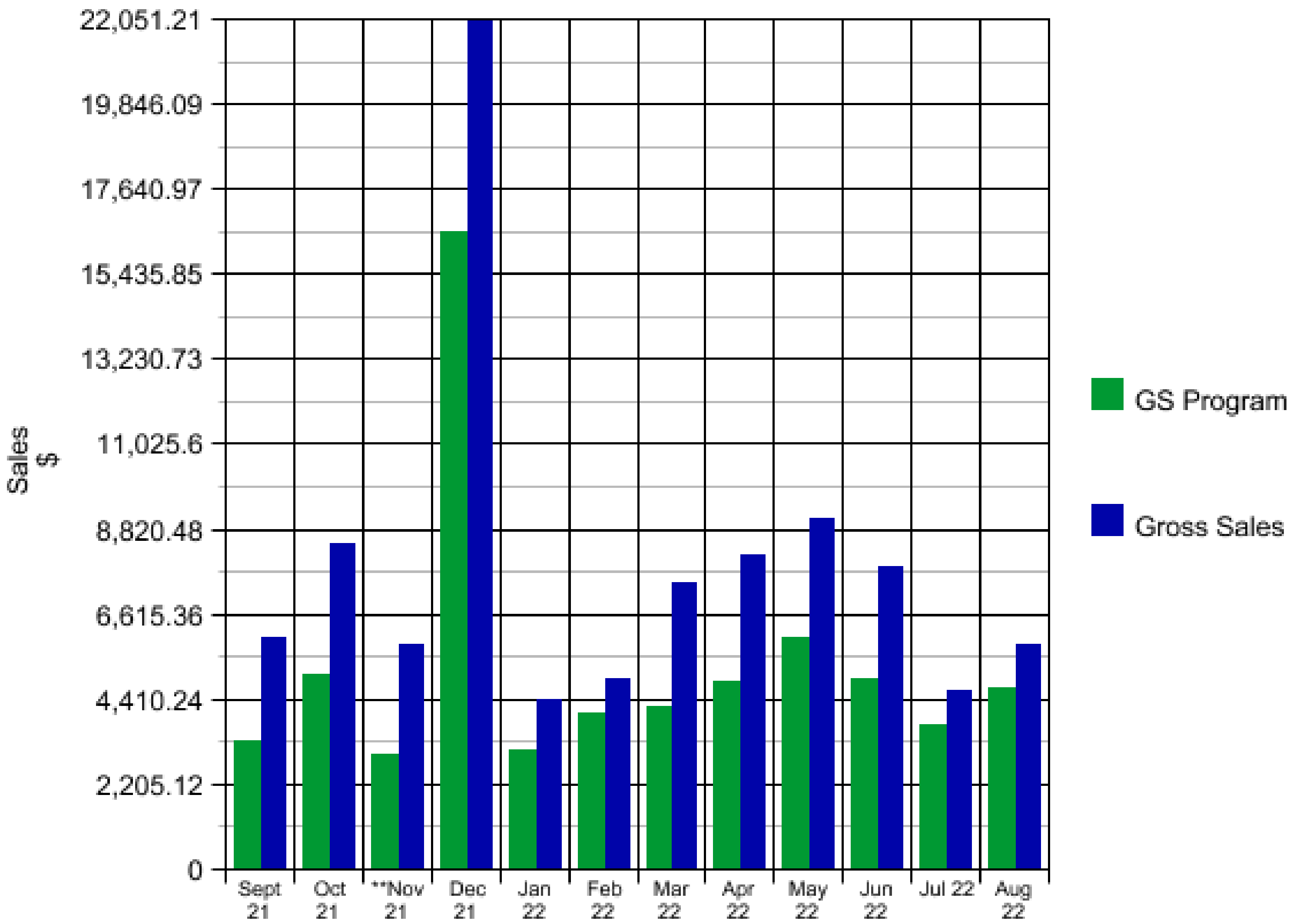

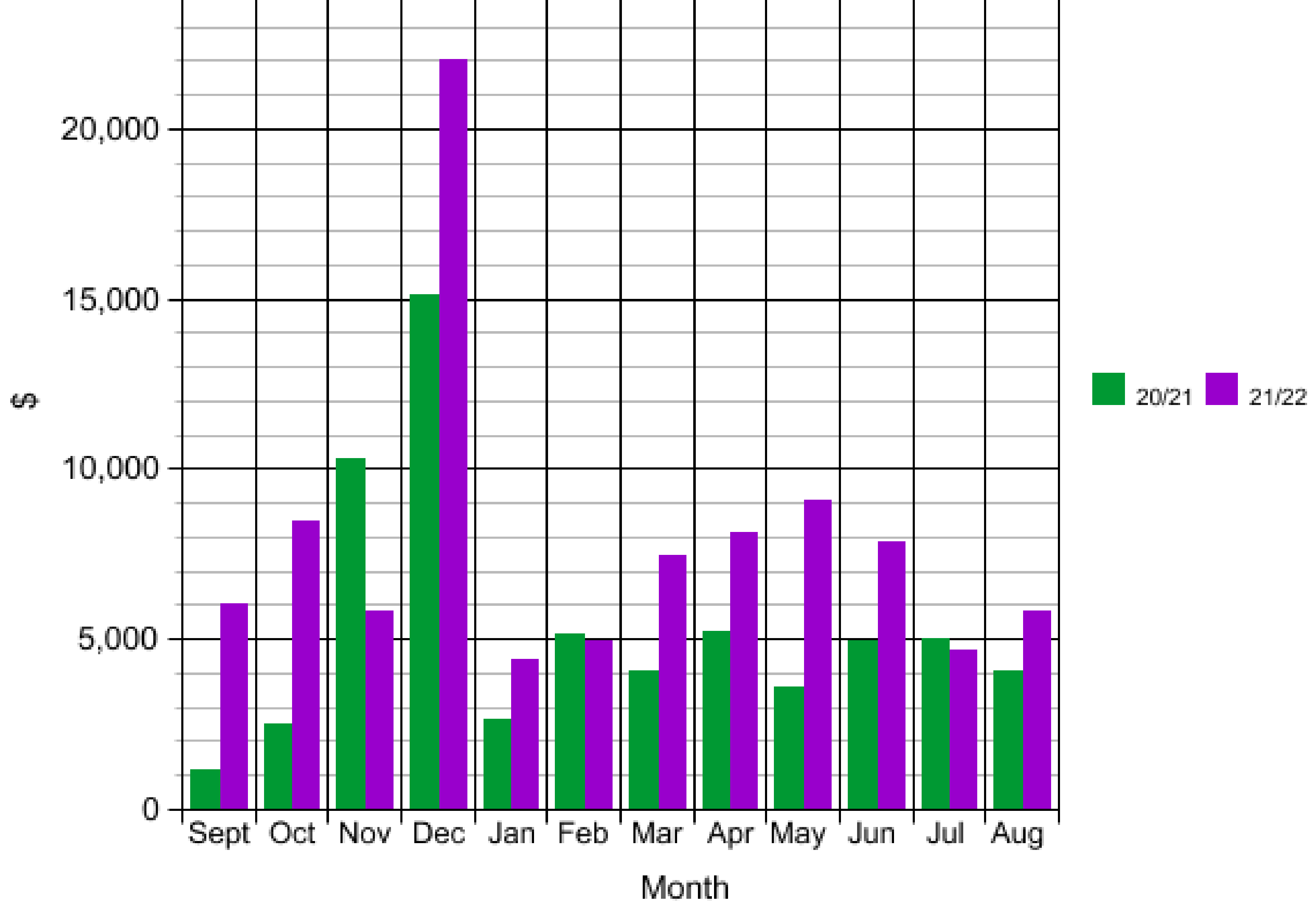
TRENDS

● OVERALL SALES

We continue to do very well month to month and have a steady collection of inventory that is regularly updated.
